
















Possible impact of removing 24 peak-only services + Stanley Bay ferry


- High level AM peak assessment undertaken by AFC
- Some reassignment from bus to rail
- Capacity
 - Concerns raised on
 - Great South Road
 - Mt Eden Rd
 - Upper Harbour Drive
 - None of the rail services go above 0.7 PT volume capacity when peak services are removed - CHECK
- Demand reduction with removal of 24 peak-only services
 - Total PT demand TO the CBD (AM peak) decrease of 900 trips (4%)
 - Similarly at regional level PT demand decreases by 1,300 when peak services are removed (2%)







Rail change in volume (07:00-09:00)











Around 900 fewer PT trips to CBD (orange)
